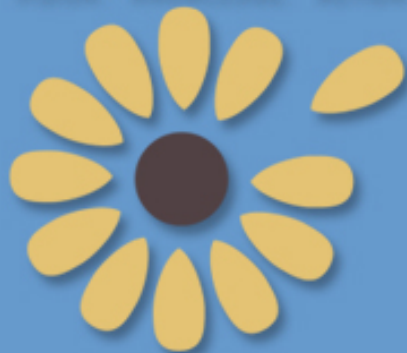

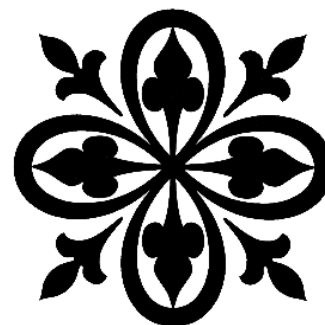

The Summer Food Service Program delivers the meals to the sites. **The meals are free (for the children and for the site).**

Last year we had 195 Summer Food sites in Louisville and we hope to surpass that this year. Any location is welcome to apply that will be providing childcare or summer activities for children (including teenagers), or that is interested in serving meals to the children in their neighborhood.
